# Helping Hand Program

The Myanmar Garment Manufacturers Association (MGMA) donated relief package includes " Rice, Oil, Medicine, Floor Mat, Shelter, solar lighting" and cash assistance to earthquake affected area in Mandalay, Innwa, Amarapura and Sagaing region on April 9<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> under MGMA Helping Hand Program.

Relief Package donated to 400 families from 5 villages at Phone Taw Naing Ngan Village, Kanthar village from Hintha District, Amarapura with heartfelt contribution by KOGAM,JGMA,CTGA and MGMA members including sourcing buyers. Donors urgently installed water pumps with solar panels at Yadanar Theingi Charitable Nunnery in Sagaing in purpose of sustainable solution of water availability for nearby villages and donated immediate relief items to 50 nuns. Donation amount is total in MMK 38,000,000 to the affected area of Sagaing and Amarapura region on 9<sup>th</sup> April, 2025.









Relief Package donated to 93 families and 7 monks from Kaw Lin Monastery and nearby 7 villages, 100 families from Atwin San Kwat Thit Village, (100) families to Hlay Gyi Tan village of Innwa region with heartfelt contribution by KOGAM,JGMA,CTGA and MGMA members including sourcing buyers. Donors urgently installed water pumps with solar panels at Hanthar Waddy Village, Innwa region to villagers in purpose of sustainable solution of water availability for nearby villages. MGMA also supported cash assistance to 80 families and who were collapsed their housing at Chan Mya Thar Si (870 Quarter), Mandalay, (6) Charitable Nunnery Schools and (3) Monastery which are terrible collapsed and lost lives in Sagaing region in total value of MMK 11,580,000. Donation amount is total in MMK 37,300,000 to the affected area of Mandalay, Sagaing and Innwa region on 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> April, 2025.





As part of follow up MGMA's Helping Hand Program, relief package and 50 bags of bread worth (4,500,000) kyats from Shwe Kyi (Yangon) donated to Sunni Jameh Mosque at Tabet Swe Village, Sein Mosque and Kyauk Mosque at Hin Ngu Village, Jameh Mosque at Khan Lu Village in Sagaing City, Kyaukse District, Mandalay Region led by executive committee members from Mandalay Region Garment Manufacturers Association (MRGMA), vehicle supported by Manaw Kyar Phyu Social Welfare Association on 2025, April 23<sup>rd</sup>.
