
# The Monthly MGMA Executive Committee Meeting

# Advanced Sewing Machine Operator Training (Batch – 13)



Myanmar Garment Manufacturers Association (MGMA) organized Advanced Sewing Machine Operator Training (Batch – 13) was held on December 1 to 12, 2025 at Myanmar Garment Human Resources Development Training Center (MGHRDC).

In this course, the trainer conducted parts of the fabric such as bag cover, spiral, shoulder corner seam, pocket, different types of bags, simple zip method, how to install a zipper, sewing sailor’s tongue, long sleeve shirt and “A” skirt with belt. In addition, (6) special sewing method such as Buttonhole sewing machine, how to sew button using sewing machine , Bartack Machine, Overlock 4 thread, Overlock 5 thread, 2 Needle taught by trainers from MGHRDC with practice session. The training attended by ( 8 ) trainees.
