

Voluntary Labour Compliance Assessment Program

MGMA conducted on-site Voluntary Labour Compliance Assessment at two factories Sen Ma Te (Myanmar) Apparel Co., Ltd and Myanmar DongTai Garment Co., Ltd in January, 2026.

Labour Officers from MGMA thoroughly reviewed all relevant supporting documents and conducted an site-tour to the workplace.

Voluntary Labour Compliance Assessment is an assessment tool implemented by the collaboration project between MGMA and ILO/ACTEMP, Bureau for Employer Activity under International Labor Organization, in 2019. VLCA was officially launched on 17th February 2020 by MGMA to all its member factories.



Helping Hand Program at Innlay Region



The Myanmar Garment Manufacturers Association (MGMA) and its members have donated funds to support the rehabilitation projects are successfully implemented in the earthquake-affected areas of Inle Region, southern Shan State, supported by Wun Yan Mhue Social Aid Society.

The rehabilitation processes are reconstruction of (16) houses in Pwal Sar Kone Village, Myaung Wa Gyi Village, Ai Daunt Gyi Village, and Kyay Sar Kone Village, well drilling and water treatment plant construction in Pwal Sar Kone Village, rebuild process of Nyaung Wun Monastery and the installation of a water pipeline supplying water from a mountain spring to the Nyaung Wun Monastery.

The donation ceremony of ten million kyat to rebuild process of Nyaung Wun Monastery and libation Ceremony for donation of water pipe to Nyaung Wun Monastery attended by MGMA CSR Team at Nyaung Wun Monastery. The ceremony was attended by the villagers , responsible persons for supervising rehabilitation process and Wun Yan Mhue Social Aid Society.
